

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING FIREWORKS

WHEREAS, the unlimited use of fireworks creates noise pollution;

WHEREAS, it is a tradition to celebrate the 4th of July and the New Year by the use of fireworks;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROY AS FOLLOWS:

The use of fireworks within the Town of Troy is prohibited except on the following dates at the following times:

1. between 5:00 P.M. and 11:30 P.M. from June 29 through July 3 and July 5 through July 9;
2. between 10:00 A.M. and Midnight on July 4;
3. between 10:00 A.M. on December 31 and 1:00 A.M. on January 1.
4. between 3:00 P.M. and Midnight at special Town events.

Any person who uses fireworks at any time besides the times set out above shall be fined in the sum of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$200.00.
